General Rules & Guidelines

- Market hours are 2:00–6:00 PM. Setup begins at 12:00 PM. Booths must be vacated by 6:45 PM.
- No sales before 1:45 PM.
- If you cannot attend a selected market date, notify Market management at least 24 hours in advance.
- If a vendor misses more than three of their selected market dates, the vendor is responsible for paying the stall fee for weeks missed.
- Vendors who are no-shows more than three times will be removed from the market.
- No bullying, harassment, intoxication, or unprofessional conduct will be tolerated.
- No smoking on market grounds.
- Leave no trace. Vendors are responsible for their own trash.
- All canopies must be safely weighted (24 lbs per leg; umbrellas require 50 lbs).
- Only locally grown or made products may be sold unless an exception is granted.
- Vendors must comply with SNAP/EBT, WIC, SFMNP, and Market Match rules.
- Social media plays a big part in a successful market. Please tag the market in your own posts

Licenses, Permits, and Insurance

The Toledo Thursday Market requires all vendors to obtain and maintain all city, county, and state licenses, permits, and insurance applicable to their business and products. Vendors may only sell products for which they hold current and valid approvals. Copies of all applicable licenses and permits must be submitted with this application or prior to the first market date.
